I. INTRODUCTORY NOTE.

Members are referred to our last Bulletin, to our Annual Report, and to our Proceedings and Transactions for further information about the Society.

With regard to the present list of additions to the Library between Victoria Day, 1904, and the same date in the present year, members are most respectfully reminded of the great difficulties which must always beset any Book Committee that has to steer a middle course between many conflicting interests and many varieties of taste, and their kind attention is again drawn to the fact that their subscriptions hardly amount to one-third of the Society's income, and that every book we buy, as well as every exchange we receive, is really a free gift from our generous benefactors. Under these circumstances all the members would naturally consider that the Book Committee is in honour bound not to devote much of its beneficiary funds to the permanent chase of the fugitive "up-to-date" will-o'-the-wisp. But, on the other hand, as a general library should always be, to some small extent, a microcosm of the whole world outside, the Committee will provide a corner for those solemn or frivolous books which contain the most representative absurdities of the day—even though the fashionable tinsel of one season is always found on the scrap-heap of the next.

About 100 volumes given by the heirs of the late James Stevenson, Esq., are included in the present Bulletin.

II.

BY-LAWS RELATING TO THE LIBRARY AND MUSEUM
(*Passed at General Meeting, May 10th, 1882.*)

1. The specimens in Natural History, and other articles contained in the collection of the Museum, the apparatus, the scientific instruments, the books and works in the Library, which the Council may deem of rarity or value, Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, and books of reference, shall not be lent or taken from the Society's room ; the Council shall, however, be authorized to lend any of the books, apparatus and scientific instruments to Members of the Society, or other scientific persons applying for the same, upon a representation, in writing, that the articles required are necessary to enable them to carry out investigations connected with the objects of the Institution, such parties undertaking to be responsible for the safety of the articles borrowed, and to return the same within a limited time, and also to make good the damage they in the meantime sustain.

2. The books and works in the Library, except those mentioned in the preceding section, may be lent to Members of the Society for a period not exceeding **fourteen days**, and no one shall be permitted to have more than **two volumes** at one time, without special permission.

All **injuries to** books, and all **losses shall** be made good to the satisfaction of the Librarian, by the person liable therefor. Books **scribbled or written in or mutilated** shall be deemed lost. A person losing one volume of a work shall be held liable for the **whole**. Every volume detained above **three months** shall be deemed lost, and the value of such book or set shall be **paid by the person detaining it**.

Members borrowing books from the Library are not **permitted to lend them** to other persons.

No person shall be permitted to take out books till the Rules and By-Laws of the Society have been fully complied with.

N. B.—Members returning books are requested to satisfy themselves that the Assistant Librarian has credited them with the book returned.
